Can breast milk be stored in a freezer?

You can store breast milk in a refrigerator with a freezer that has a separate door (0°F or -18°C) for up to 12 months, although using it within six months is preferable. The earlier you use your breast milk, the better, because longer storage can diminish the amount of vitamin C in it. The temperature of your freezer should be around 0°F; F.

How long can breast milk be stored?

Never store breast milk in disposable bottle liners or plastic bags that are not intended for storing breast milk. Freshly expressed or pumped milk can be stored: At room temperature (77°F or colder) for up to 4 hours. In the refrigerator for up to 4 days. In the freezer for about 6 months is best; up to 12 months is acceptable.

How long can you keep frozen breast milk?

But it's best to use the frozen milk within six months. Keep in mind that research suggests the longer you store breast milk -- whether in the refrigerator or in the freezer -- the greater the loss of vitamin C in the milk. It's also important to note that your breast milk changes to meet your baby's needs.

How long can you keep breast milk in the fridge?

Up to 4 days is best. Store breast milk in the back of the refrigerator. To warm breast milk, place the bottle in a bowl of warm water or run it under warm water. Do not microwave it. Store breast milk in the back of the refrigerator.

Place the containers in the back of the refrigerator or freezer, where the temperature is the coolest. If you don't have access to a refrigerator or freezer, store the milk in an insulated cooler ...

Breast milk can be stored in an insulated cooler with frozen ice packs for up to 24 hours when traveling. At your destination, use the milk right away, store it in the refrigerator, or freeze it. ...

If you will be storing your breast milk at home, please use the table below to determine how long you can store fresh, frozen, and thawed milk at home. Store milk in the coldest part of the refrigerator or ...

Freshly expressed breast milk can be left out at room temperature for up to four hours, and if left out--versus stored in the fridge right away--is best for immediate use.

Freeze breast milk if you will not be using it within 48-72 hours. Breast milk expands as it freezes, so do not fill the milk all the way to the top of the storage container. Remember, store the milk in the back ...
