How much does it cost to move a container?

On average, moving a container within the United States costs around \$2,000-\$5,000. For international moves, the price of a shipping container can be from \$5,000 to \$10,000. If you're moving an empty container over a short distance (under 200 miles), you may pay between \$500 and \$1000.

How much does it cost to deliver a container?

Buying the container is only step one. Real costs often come from delivery, setup, and compliance. Example: Delivering a 40ft container from the Port of Newark to Pittsburgh (370 miles) may cost \$1,600+ in transport and unloading fees. A flatbed truck can only deliver if the ground is ready. If not, you'll need site prep:

The global container fleet consists of over 30 million TEUs (twenty-foot equivalent units), but availability can fluctuate wildly. Overproduction during boom times often leads to price drops.
